- My skill development
- My intellectual development & adaptive behavior
- My rate of progress
- My learning styles
- My strengths, preferences, & interests
- My academic, functional, and developmental needs
- My concerns & my parents concerns

What are my goals for life after I exit?

Transition Needs & Course of Study

In reflection of PLP/MPSGs/Assessments:

- What skills should I learn?
- What experiences will I need?
- What supports/linkages will I need?
