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		School Program	<ul> <li>due to safety walking students to Cameron after school</li> <li>Cameron has a memorandum of understanding with the district and we are asking for them to come in and present their model to SBPT</li> <li>Right now Cameron would like to provide tutoring for our students and have qualified staff to provide that tutoring.</li> <li>Cameron will be using the cafeteria, Rooms 109, 117, Zen Room, and the Computer Lab from 3:45-7:00.</li> <li>Staff ratio is 2 adult to every 6 kids and sometimes 1:1 support.</li> <li>FCS After School Model review</li> <li>2 models (Model A and C) were approved by the RCSD School Board</li> <li>Model B was not approved due to transportation</li> <li>SBPT will go back to constituents since model B was the model that received the most votes and allow them to vote on Model A or C. We will be adding a primary unit to each model so that there is equity.</li> <li>Model A was a similar model to last year and is from April 9-June 21 and includes enrichment and intervention for all grades.</li> <li>Model C will now include Test Prep for 3-6 and a focus on intervention for K-2 along with enrichment opportunities for all grade levels February 28-May 18</li> </ul>
