WHEREAS, in reliance upon the State Teachers Retirement System's direction, on June 23, 2010, the Board approved Resolution 2009-10: 1015A which sought to make the "open period" for Part B retroactive to June 2, 2010 and cover the period of June 2, 2010 through August 30, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the New York State and Local Retirement System thereafter advised the District that Part B may not be implemented retroactively and should begin immediately after the date of election; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Education of the Rochester City School District does hereby elect to provide the benefits of the 2010 Retirement Incentive Program, Part B - Chapter 105 of the Laws of 2010, to all eligible employees who retire with an effective date of retirement during an "open period" commencing on June 18, 2010, and ending on August 31, 2010, and who are otherwise eligible to participate in such program; and
