In addition, to promote a safe, healthy, orderly and civil school environment, all District students have the right to:

Take part in all district activities on an equal basis regardless of race, color, creed, national origin, religion, **sex**, gender **identity and expression**, [or], sexual orientation and disability.

Alternative Assessments

Whereas, the Board of Education has determined that a growing body of educational research and advocacy, support the conclusions that (a) the correlation between high-stakes testing and student success is weak; (b) such testing does not reasonably examine students for competency across the full range of State learning standards; (c) that no single test score can definitively measure student knowledge; (d) that such testing in heavily, if unintentionally, weighted against the needs and capacities of significant numbers of students, particularly those with differing learning styles, or under high psychological stress, or those with English-language difficulties and (e) such testing can operate to narrow actual curriculum, as schools focus upon preparation for a single test, as distinct from pedagogy favoring a more expanded curriculum utilizing a range of test forms; and

Whereas, the Board has determined that the unavailability of a range of alternative assessments is detrimental to both the short and long term educational needs of our students, it is

Resolved, that the Board of Education hereby declares its support for State sanction of a range of alternative assessments for student achievement, and calls upon the citizens of the City of Rochester and the County of Monroe, and upon the City and County governments, and the officials of the school districts, towns and villages of this County to join in its call for an expansion of assessment devices to measure student achievement; and it is

Further resolved, that the Board expressly authorizes the Superintendent of Schools to communicate this resolution to the New York State Commissioner of Education, and to work with State legislators and with the State Department of Education toward the adoption of a program of alternative assessments, as contemplated by this Resolution. This resolution does not authorize any policy of the Board, or implementation of any policy on this issue. The Administration is to come back to the Board with a policy, and implementation plan, for thorough review and consideration by the Board.
