Welcome! AP Language and Composition is an intensive course in which scholars engage with complex rhetorical texts in preparation for college-level coursework. The course emphasizes extensive reading, discussion, analysis, and writing of both classic and contemporary rhetorical texts.. Students are expected to complete all in-class and independent reading assignments and papers. Please note that this year's Advanced Placement English Literature and Composition exam will be held on **Wednesday, May 11, 2016**.

Materials

The following materials are required for class. Please bring these materials to class by Wednesday, September 9, 2015.

1. English Binder: Students will need room in the binder for **four** sections as follows:
 - a. Section 1—Texts: Notes and Homework
 - b. Section 2—Grammar and Mechanics: Notes and Homework
 - c. Section 3—Spelling and Vocabulary: Notes and Homework
 - d. Section 4—Test Prep
2. Two folders (one pocket for each section)
3. Two pens (**blue or black ink**)
4. Two pencils (#2 lead) with erasers
5. Loose leaf paper
6. An assignment pad/agenda
7. A dictionary (for use at home)

Grades

Grades will be based on the following:

- Class work/participation/ production based on lessons, discussions, etc.
- Tests, Quizzes
- Homework
- Projects and Presentations
- Papers (includes formatting and citation)

Grade values may vary from marking period to marking period depending on specific assignments and projects.
