Daniel S. DiClemente Student Scholarship

BENTE, the Board of Education Non-Teaching Employees Union, represents over 1,200 support staff workers in the Rochester City School District in the areas of Transportation, Clerical, School Safety Officers, Maintenance, Custodial, Occupational and Physical Therapy, Storehouse, Food Service, and Attendance. We are "The Support Staff That Supports Students!"

In 2009, Daniel S. DiClemente, the President of BENTE Local 2419 (2002-2023), instituted the BENTE Scholarship as a way for BENTE to give back to our community, particularly the students of the Rochester City School District. As of 2025, we have renamed the scholarship in honor of President DiClemente, in recognition of his long-time service to Rochester and its students and families.

BENTE will award two \$500 scholarships, one each to two Rochester City School students in an effort to help defray costs of attendance upon acceptance to a 2-4 college degree program or certificate/degree program in the trades industries.

A rating system of 100 points will be used in determining the winner:

- 1. Up to 30 points: Academic Performance (must attach transcript)
- 2. Up to 35 points: Biographical Information and Statement of Need Applicants Essay/Letter of Career Interest
- 3. Up to 20 points: Recommendations by Counselors and/or Teachers
- 4. Up to 15 points: Community/Extra-Curricular Involvement

(Applicant is encouraged to attach a separate sheet and list all activities during his/her high school career.)
