Nuts & Bolts...

- What do Admissions Counselors consider when reviewing applications?
 - Quality of the high school transcript
 - Level of coursework
 - AP
 - Honors
 - Regents
 - Grades
 - Senior schedule

Nuts and Bolts...

- Standardized College Entrance Exams
 - SAT*- SAT School Day- Monday 10/28
 - ACT*
 - Check college websites for test optional policies post-COVID.
- * College requirements vary. Most will accept the SAT and/or the ACT. Check with an admissions representative or visit the college website for clarification.

Nuts and Bolts...

- Recommendations
 - Generally 1- 2, varies by institution
- Extracurricular Activities
 - Consistent, substantive, demonstrations of talent and leadership
 - Community Service
- College Essay
- Interviews
 - May not require, but many encourage.
 - Demonstrated Interest

Nuts and Bolts...

- Portfolios and Auditions
 - Very important for students continuing with art at the college level. Work closely with your SOTA art teachers to ensure you are meeting all of the criteria and deadlines for college admission.

The Admissions Process

- 1) Complete College Applications
- 2) Add Colleges to SchoolLinks
- 3) Work with Counselor to Submit Supporting Documents
- 4) Submit SAT/ACT Scores through testing agency if required
- 5) Complete FAFSA for Financial Aid

The Admissions Process...

- Admissions Deadlines
 - Early Decision
 - Early Action
 - Rolling Admission
 - Regular Decision
 - College Application Fee Waivers

The Admissions Process...

- Basic Student Application Form
 - Personal Information
 - Essay
 - Secondary School Report
 - Teacher Recommendations
 - Test Scores (if required)
 - Audition / Art Portfolio
 - Supplemental Application Forms
 - Fee Waivers
