Graduation August	13 Scholars are expected to graduate on Thursday evening 8/26 @ 6:00 PM, 1 from Cohort 2016, 7 from Cohort 2017, and 5 from Cohort 2018. Final Graduation rate for Class of 2021 is 85.3% (151/177)					
Di's	e state has decided that all DI's will simply carryover for this year with the same act targets that were previously set. See below. The baseline numbers come m 2015 if you were wondering. The status is where we are as of August 2021.					
Cell Phones	As a way to minimize contact (we will need only 4 teachers to help with morning collection) we have decided to continue to have scholars come through the PE door area for scanning. Bins will be placed along the walkway for scholars to grab their own envelopes and put their own phone in the envelope for quick handing in when they get closer to scanning. Teachers will oversee this process of student putting phones into envelopes. The envelopes this year will have their names in large letters and will also have numbers underneath the names. This will make reordering them for the end of the day much quicker and we will only have the phones collected not ALL envelopes in the same bins.					
	At the end of the day, we will still need support from (10) teachers to hand them back out. Gloves are expected to be worn by staff. We will spread out throughout the hallways on the first floor for return to maximize distancing and will only dismiss one floor at a time to try and limit density at the return bins. It will be essential for this reason that teachers hold students in the classroom until your floor has been called.					
	All teachers will be asked to participate for one quarter of the year. This keeps it equitable. Teachers will report for collection by 7:25 in the morning and by 3:20 in the afternoon for return. If you are a substitute collector or returner, please report each day in case you are needed. Sometimes we have unexpected absences at the beginning or end of the day with very short notice, so having the substitutes report is very useful and keeps us from being short handed.					
Announcements	We can finally do announcements agin for each individual school. We want to do announcements daily for a maximum of five minutes (8:00-8:05). Possible announcments could be: Date, Day (ABCD), birthdays, upcoming sports games, words of wisdometc. We need one RTA member to oversee/advise morning announcements.
