

**Urban Choice Charter School Charter School Public Hearing
September 24, 2020
Minutes**

Attendance: President Van White, Commissioner Willa Powell, Superintendent Lesli Myers-Small, Executive Assistant Francine Scott and District Clerk Kallia Wade.

President White opened the hearing at 6:05 p.m.

President White noted that the Education Law subdivision 2857(1) and regulations of the Commissioner of Education 8 N.Y.C.R.R. § 119.4 require the Board to conduct a public hearing within 30 days of receipt of notice of an application for a new or revised charter school.

President White explained that the Board of Education of the Rochester City School District is conducting this public hearing to gather community input regarding the renewal application for Urban Choice Charter School. President White further explained that Urban Choice Charter School serves 400 students in Kindergarten through grade 8. He also added that according to the renewal application, Urban Choice Charter School plans to add a Comprehensive Management Service Provider, the Center for Educational Innovation, beginning in the 2020-2021 School Year and proposes a new charter term July 21, 2021 through June 2026

President White then requested public comment regarding the school.
