- II. NYS Assessments (ELA, Math, Science)

NYS ELA and Math assessments will be administered on the Monday of testing week. Only the hybrid students are being tested. The remote students will be assigned asynchronous work for that day only. All make-ups will occur the following three inperson learning days. The grade 4 science assessment will occur in June. Only hybrid students will take the written portion. The performance assessment will not be given this year. More information will follow.

III. myView Assessment K-5

A concern has arisen that the assessment, given through Realize, does not give accurate data. Students have a hard time accessing the site remotely. SBPT has decided as a team that giving myView <u>assessments is no longer required for this school year</u>. Teachers have the option to assess their students if they would like.

IV. NWEA

The team discussed how we plan administer the NWEA for the end of year. Some questions that were brought up are:

Are we administering to the hybrid and remote students at the same time? What technology will be used for grades K-2?

Mr. Wingo and Mrs. Michel will send out the district guidelines for NWEA. They will solicit feedback from teachers on ways to administer the assessments.
