- I. Members signed off on previous meeting's minutes
- II. Science Assessments

Only 4<sup>th</sup> grade remote students will be asynchronous for the June 7<sup>th</sup> exam.

#### III. NWEA

Some teachers were concerned about completing NWEA testing for all of their students. Pam Kuek and Michele created a schedule to assist with this.

#### IV. Close Out Procedures

Lisa Garrow addressed this at the May 12<sup>th</sup> Staff Meeting. She will be sending out a document with the information.

We will have a sign up for sign out in the office Tuesday, June 22<sup>nd</sup> at 8:30. Wednesday will be our closeout day. Everything will be done by the end of day. In previous SBPT minutes, it was decided that the current classes would remain together and move up to the next grade level. Refer to last month's minutes.

If you are a summer school teacher, you will sign your things out for summer with Mr. Wingo or Mr. Burns.

## V. Writing Curriculum (myView/BAW)

There has been no training on myView writing. Teachers like BAW better. Can we switch to Being a Writer during Writer's Workshop? L. Garrow would like to move back to BAW pending approval from the school chief.

## VI. Monthly Classroom Newsletter

Starting in September, newsletters will be due to admin by the Monday of the 3rd week of the previous month (October's newsletter will be due to administration for approval on Monday, September 20<sup>th</sup>). The Newsletter needs to be sent home by the last Friday of the month.

#### VII. Math Instructional Time

Classroom teachers were concerned about lack of time for core instruction. MTSS time caused confusion. According to district information, core grade level curriculum should be taught for 60 minutes. The MTSS (Zearn, etc.) should be an additional 30 minutes. This will continue to be the expectation.

VIII. Core Assessments for 2021-2022 (myView, CFA, Teacher created CFAs for math)

In deference to the amount of testing being asked of students, we compared CFAs and myView assessments for ELA and End of Module Assessments and District CFAs in math. SBPT felt that the CFAs for ELA seemed much more aligned to NYS standards. We would like to move to only doing CFAs for K-6 ELA.

The district says the End of Module assessments are not cumulative so they are not considered good indicator. We are required to do 3 benchmarks throughout the year. Teachers can still use End of Module assessments for their own information, if they choose. SBPT voted and approved the plan for K-6 to use the math district CFAs as our benchmarks.
