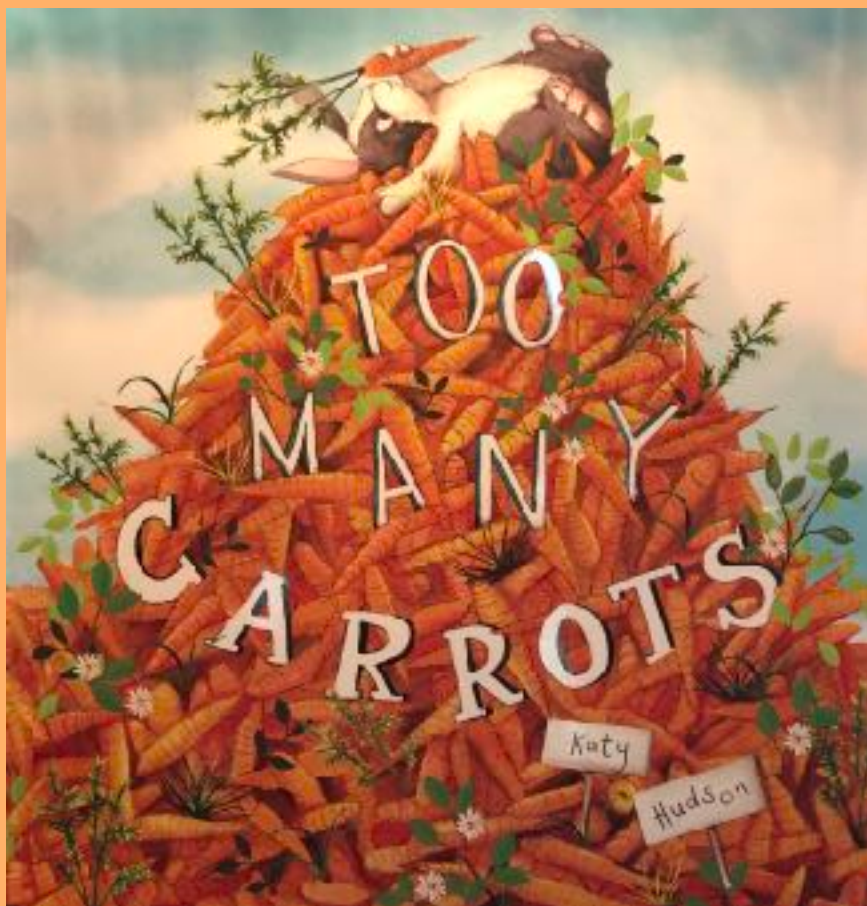


# Too Many Carrots
